LIFT TICKETS AT REVELSTOKE MOUNTAIN RESORT

Revelstoke Mountain Resort offers reduced ticket prices to athletes. To purchase tickets:

- Athletes must purchase tickets at resort ticket booth
- Athletes must show/wear their bib
- MC/Visa accepted
- Ticket office opens at 8am daily with lift opening at 8:30 am
- Ticket price \$45.00 incl tax on training days and \$30.00 incl tax* on competition days

Complimentary lift tickets for coaching staff, judges, and officials are available at the Race Office each day.

REGISTRATION

*Coaches must email athlete information to registrar prior to February 3rd

- Athletes must have current FIS registration and provide verification.
- Changes can be made at any time.
- Registration fees must be paid with **check or cash only**-
- Bib deposit fees must be paid separately with cash or check.

Please note, visa and mastercard are not acceptable forms of payment for registration. Cash or check only.

REGISTRATION COST (cash or check payable to Revelstoke Freestyle Ski Club)

- \$125 first event.
- additional \$75 for second event.

BIB DEPOSIT

- \$30 (cash or check payable to Revelstoke Freestyle Club)





•Bibs must be returned to race office after the event at the competition office at Nelsen Lodge to receive deposit back

REFUND POLICY

•If a competition is cancelled \$CAN33 shall be refunded to each athlete registered for that event. An athlete shall receive a maximum refund of \$CAN33 per competition even if she/he is registered in more than one event that is cancelled. If an event is rescheduled at another venue \$CAN33 will be charged to the participating athletes.

•Injury Refund Policy: A registered athlete who withdraws from an event before the generation of the start list will receive a refund of 50% of their entry fee. Athletes that appear on the official start list for an event will not be given a refund. No refunds will be given without a written request received no later than 7 days after the completion of the last event day.
